Evidence is Everything. First, make sure it's safe and secure.

Photos, videos, screenshots, documents, messages, audio and more can all be securely stored on **kulpa** to ensure it holds evidential weight and can be used to support a criminal or civil case, should you choose to use it.

Uploading your evidence to kulpa gives you options. There is no requirement to share it with anyone. But, if you decide you need help, you can share your verified evidence directly with the Police or send the details to a civil lawyer.

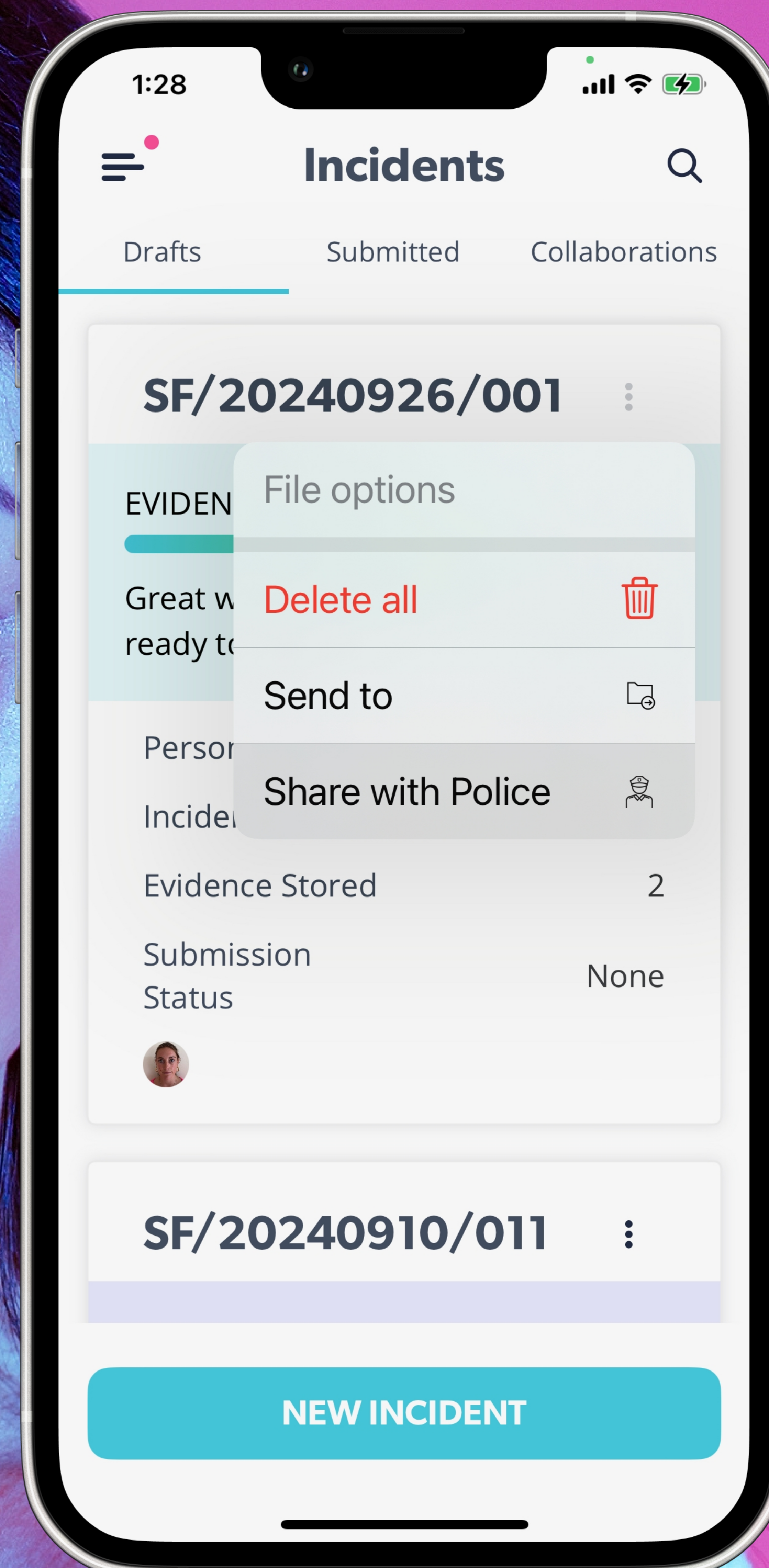
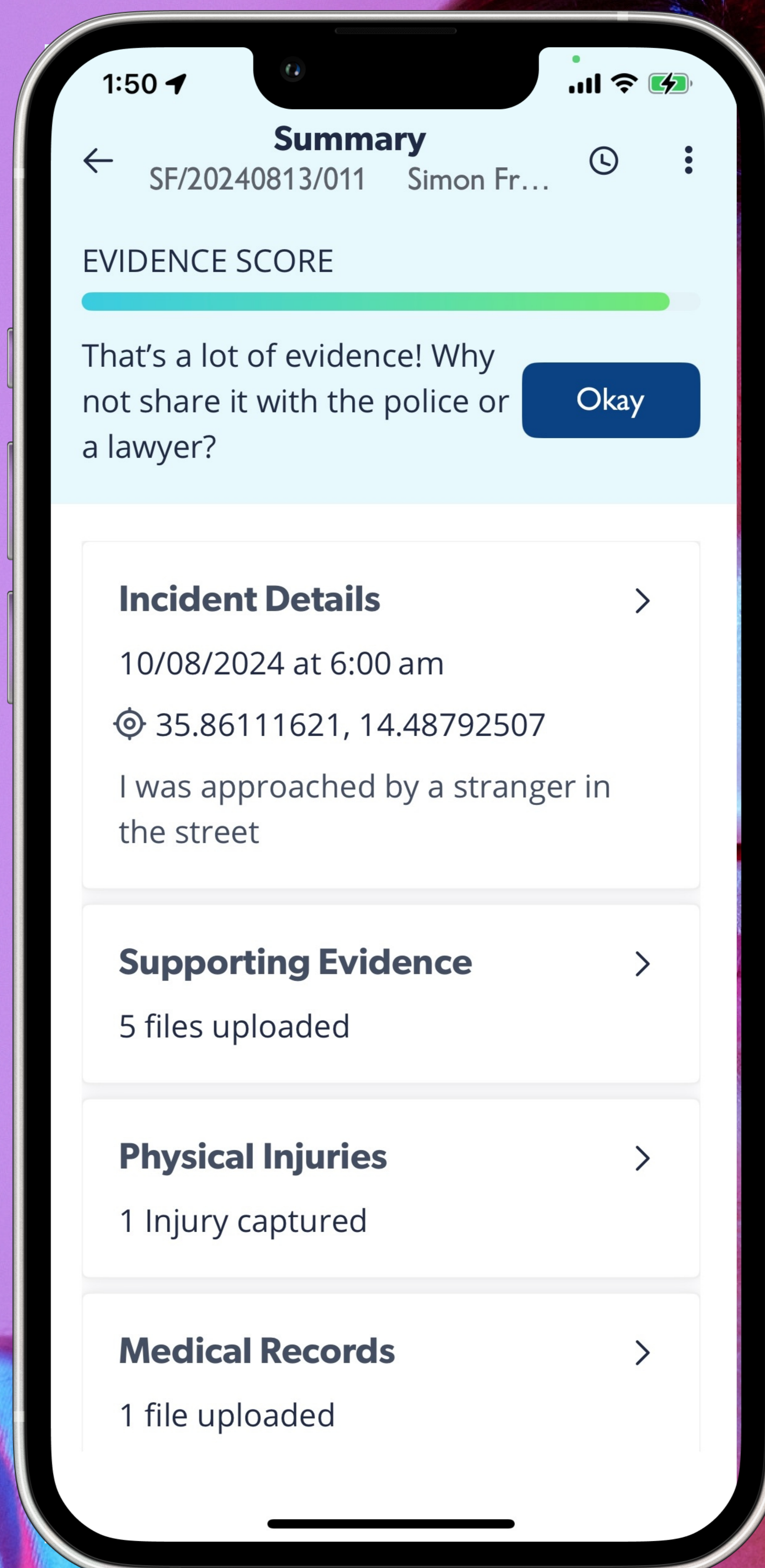
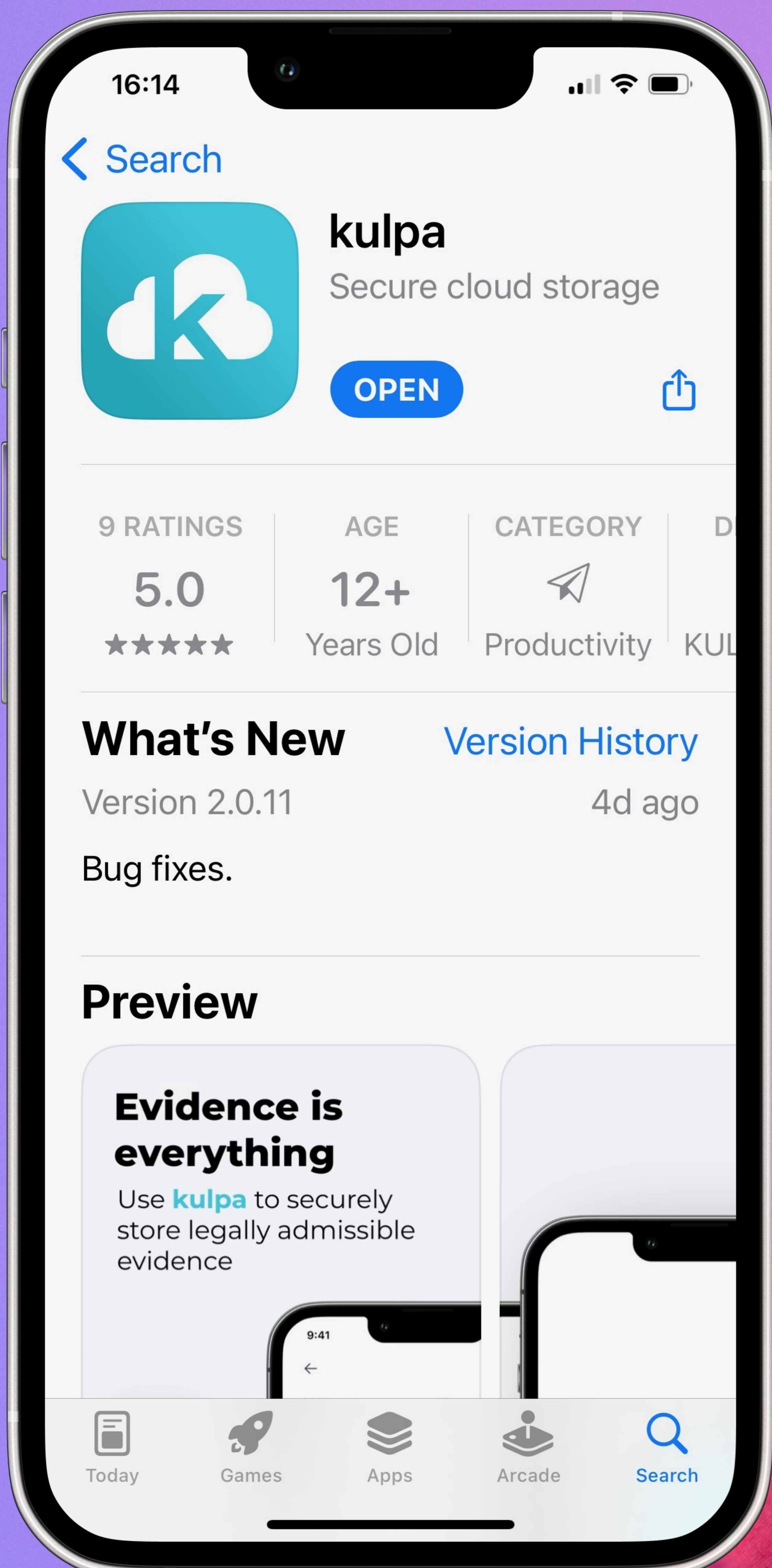

Take these simple steps and feel empowered:



1. Download the free kulpa app

The app is available on the iOS App Store and Google Play store. **Search 'kulpa'.**

SAFETY TIPS

The app is protected by a unique PIN which you choose when you sign up for the first time. Your evidence can't be accessed without this PIN.

If you don't want to keep the app on your device, you don't need to. You can download it, upload your evidence and then delete the app again. Your data will not be deleted but will remain safe and secure.

2. Upload your evidence

Document what happened.

It's important that you securely store any and all evidence that you have.

Messages, call logs, social media - screenshot it and upload it; it's all evidence. Plus, don't forget to upload any relevant pictures, videos and audio files.

Storing your evidence on the kulpa cloud ensures that it can be used to support a civil or criminal process - if, and when, you choose to share it.

3. It's now your decision

Your evidence will remain safe, secure and private. Ready, for when...

You decide to send your evidence to anyone you like, or to a kulpa accredited lawyer who will be able to give you initial free civil legal advice. Perhaps you need a protective or restraining order; or

You decide to share your evidence with the Police. The evidence you share can then be immediately used by police to safeguard you and swiftly investigate.
